## Description of Facilities

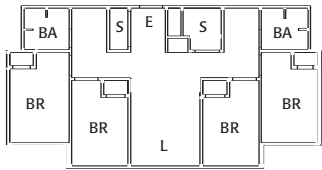
### Residence Halls

The residence halls offer a variety of floor plan options. On each floor, rooms are clustered on one of two wings forming small living groups. Each residence hall features common area lounges with televisions for meeting and socializing, laundry facilities, and a staffed service desk. Rooms have cable boxes for local television service, and computer network (ethernet) connections. Kitchens are not provided in the residence halls. We furnish beds, mattresses, linens, bath towels and amenities, dressers, desks, desk chairs, and closets.

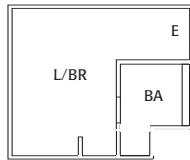
### Apartments

Apartments for conference housing offer four single bedrooms per unit. Rooms have local telephone service, cable TV, and ethernet hookup. Each apartment offers a kitchen, living room, bathroom and storage areas for guests. We furnish everything indicated above for the residence halls plus a stove, refrigerator, dishwasher, dining room table, dining chairs, two loveseats, two end tables, and two living room chairs. Kitchen utensils and dishes are not provided, and linen service is not available for apartments.

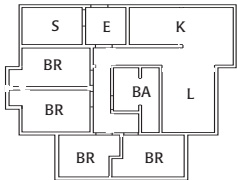
### Room/Apartment Floor Plans



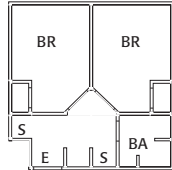
Quad Suite – Single Bedrooms

Double Suite – Single Bedrooms

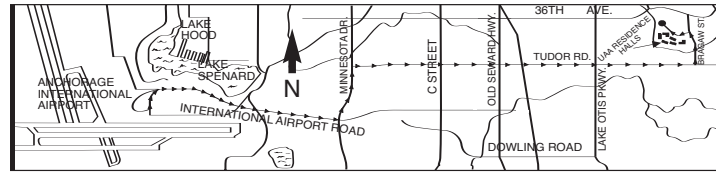

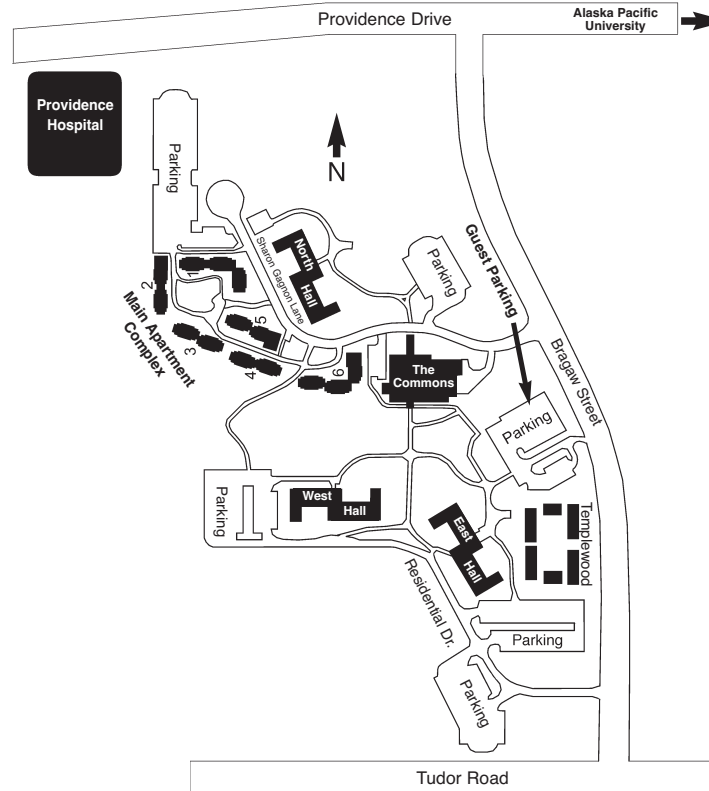

# Welcome to UAA Guest Housing

## Hospitality Services & Information

### ▶ Checking into UAA Guest Housing

Guests may check-in after 3 p.m. on the day of their arrival. For check-in to the residence halls, vehicles may pull into the loading zone directly in front of each Hall for temporary loading and unloading. Guests must check out of their rooms no later than 12 noon on the day of their departure. Guests checking into the MAC and Templewood apartments will go to North Hall to check-in. The front desk of each residence hall is staffed 24 hours 7 days a week.

### ▶ Parking

The UAA campus requires a permit to park in the guest housing lots. The "Pay N' Park" machine is located at the Willow guest parking lot [see map on reverse]. The permits are either \$10 for the day pass or \$2 per hour. Alternatively, guests may go online to [www.thepermitstore.com](http://www.thepermitstore.com) to purchase a \$25 summer permit before arrival to be used for the entire guest stay. Summer conference guests may park in any of the parking lots adjacent to the residence halls excluding restricted spaces, driveways, or fire lanes.

### ▶ The Commons

The Commons, located at 3700 Sharon Gagnon Lane, is the social center of the residence halls. The Commons houses the Creekside Eatery dining facility, Bear Necessities convenience store, Power House Fitness Center, computer lab, and a lounge area with fireplace. Housing guests are welcome to utilize these facilities.

### ▶ Linens

Linen service is provided for you during your stay at the residence halls. Linens include bedding and bath towels. Housekeeping service is not provided, and it may be necessary for guests to make their own beds during their stay. Soiled towels, wash cloths and sheets can be exchanged for clean linen through the front desk of each hall.

### ▶ Complimentary Services

For your convenience, the following items are available to you:

- ▶ Telephones
- ▶ Alaska tourist information in each bedroom
- ▶ Complimentary coffee in each suite
- ▶ Alarm clock

### ▶ Special Accommodations for Guests with Disabilities

Rooms are available within the UAA residence halls (not Templewood units) designed to accommodate individuals with disabilities. These units are completely accessible and exceed ADA standards. It is important to give UAA as much advanced notice as possible that handicap access or hearing impaired rooms are needed. If you find you require other special assistance upon arrival to campus, contact the Conference Services office and our staff will do their best to accommodate you.

### ▶ Medical Services

Emergency response teams may be reached by dialing **911** on a public phone, or **6-1120** on a campus telephone. Providence Alaska Medical Center and the Alaska Native Medical Center are located adjacent to the residential community.

### ▶ Wildlife

UAA's residential community is surrounded by wooded areas, a creek, and protected wetlands. We often have the unique opportunity to witness up close various species of Alaskan wildlife including moose, ducks, geese, and beavers. Please respect our coexistence with these and other creatures that may visit us. Do not attempt to pet, feed or approach any of these animals for any reason. Moose, especially mothers with a nearby calf, have been known to charge. Feeding animals disrupts their search for food and endangers their survival. Enjoy our unique setting from a safe distance, but please do not disturb the animals.

## Safety & Security

Concerns about personal safety and the security of property are shared by all segments of the University community; at UAA "Safety is Everybody's Business." For your safety, regular patrols of the residence halls are maintained. Summer Conference staff are on duty from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. The UAA residence halls are also patrolled regularly by commissioned University Police Officers. Do your part; the security of your room depends upon you and your fellow guests working together with UAA to promote a safety-conscious community. Please keep both your suite and bedroom doors locked at all times.

## Other Important Considerations

- ▶ Individuals under 21 years of age may not bring alcoholic beverages to, or consume them in the residence hall area.
- ▶ The UAA residence halls are nonsmoking facilities. If you smoke, please do so in designated smoking areas at the entrance of buildings and The Commons. Thank you for your cooperation.
- ▶ Illegal substances are not allowed anywhere on campus or in the residence halls.
- ▶ Fuel storage is prohibited in the residence halls and on University property.
- ▶ Pets other than guide dogs for the visually or hearing impaired will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
- ▶ UAA is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property.
- ▶ Violation of any University Housing policy may result in your immediate removal from UAA Housing.
